Kenya's skies are amazing, but the winds here can be tricky. That's why we guide you step by step through a safe and exciting training journey, from your very first ground practice to flying solo.

What You'll Learn

We follow the PAK (Paragliding Association of Kenya) training program, split into two fun levels:

PAK1 – Ground School

This is where the magic starts!

- 4 days of training (over 2 weekends, weather permitting)
- Overnight at [Elwai Centre](#) or other, for Saturday night(at own cost)
- Learn the basics of paragliding theory
- Practice controlling the glider on the ground
- Master confident take-offs and short “hops”

◆ By the end: you'll be able to train independently on the ground!

PAK2 – Flight School (Personal Paragliding Equipment required)

Time to take to the skies!

- 4 more training days (over 2 weekends)
- Overnight at [Elwai Centre](#) or other, for Saturday/Sunday (at own cost)
- Learn more theory
- Practice under radio supervision with your instructor
- Complete 15 flights in calm air and 1 higher-altitude flights (over 600m!)

◆ By the end: you'll be ready to fly solo in still air—with radio guidance for safety.

Certification

After completion of PAK1, you'll receive a certificate of completion in which all your training levels can be endorsed.

After the PAK2 written exam you can apply for a your official PAK Paragliding License.

All our instructors/mentors are PAK-certified, experienced, and most importantly—committed to your safety and fun.

What You Need Before Training

What to Wear

- Hiking shoes (ankle high)
- Long trousers & a long-sleeved shirt
- Basic light fullhand gloves (best are climbing gloves)
- A (skateboarding) helmet (easy to find at Decathlon)

Where We Train

Depending on the weather, training takes place:

- North of Nairobi (Longonot area, about 1.5h north of Nairobi)
- South of Nairobi (near Konza, about 1.5h south of Nairobi)

Camping and local stays are available, and we can arrange transport for USD 40 per person.

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTIONS ABOUT GEAR

Do you rent paragliding gear for training?

Due to little demand, we do rent out training gear

- For PAK1 Training, the paragliding training gear is included in the price
- For PAK2 Training you need to have your own gear

What gear do I need for P2 training?

You need your own full paragliding kit, which consists of:

1. Paraglider Wing
2. Harness
3. Safety Parachute

The paraglider, harness and safety parachute need to be correctly sized for each pilot, to ensure maximum safety during flight. Cloudbase Kenya will advise you well on this.

How much does new paragliding kit cost and how long can I use it for?

It depends on what you choose, estimated Euro 4500 – 5500.

If kept well you will enjoy flying with your gear 10-15 years. Paragliding Kit has great resell value.



Does my first paragliding kit have to be new or can I buy second hand gear?

There is a huge second-hand paraglider market online. The challenge is, that you will most probably order used gear from abroad. This can be tricky as you cannot visually inspect the gear before ordering it.

Therefore, we advise to purchase new paragliding kit from us. The advantage is, that you will be well advised of what to purchase and there are product warranties in place.

QUESTIONS ABOUT TRAINING

When do I become an independent pilot?

After PAK2 training.

If you feel confident to fly without supervision, talk to your instructor and he will advise you.

After PAK guidelines, you can fly without radio supervision after PAK3 level, but you can request to fly independently after PAK2 training

Do you issue a Kenya Paragliding License?

The Paragliding Association of Kenya (PAK) can issue you a license, endorsing your paragliding skill levels PAK1 to PAK5 in it in the PAK Paragliding License Booklet.

What is the shipment time of ordered paragliding kit?
