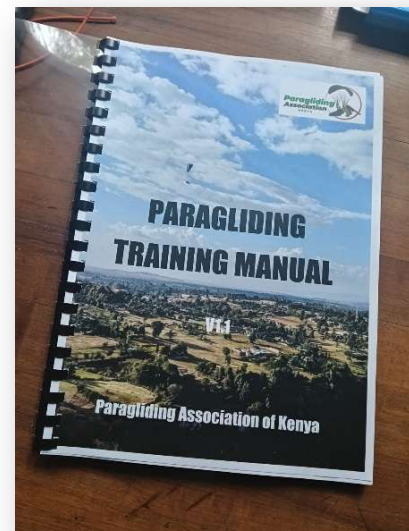

The Training Program

1. PAK1 – Ground Handling

2. **3 days** of ground training and first short flights ([Mt Sophie](#))
3. 2 nights' accommodation hb in cabin next to training hill ([Mt Sophie](#))
 - Learn the basics of paragliding theory
 - Practice controlling the glider on the ground
 - Master confident take-offs and landing with short flights
 - GOAL: You'll be able to train independently on the ground

4. PAK2 – Flight Training

(Personal Paragliding Equipment required)

- **3 days** of ground training and first higher flights ([Kijabe Hill](#))
- 2 nights' accommodation hb in cabin next to training hill ([Mt Sophie](#))
- Learn more theory
- Practice under radio supervision
- Complete Short flights in calm air and 8 higher-altitude flight
- GOAL: You'll be ready to fly solo in still air—with radio guidance

Frequently Asked Questions

QUESTIONS ABOUT GEAR

Do you rent paragliding gear for training?

- For PAK1 Training, the paragliding training gear is included in the price
- For PAK2 Training you need to have your own gear
- If its impossible to have your own gear, we might be able to rent you gear

What gear do I need for PAK2 training?

You need your own full paragliding kit, which consists of:

1. Paraglider Wing
2. Harness
3. Safety Parachute

The paraglider, harness and safety parachute need to be correctly sized for each pilot, to ensure maximum safety during flight. Cloudbase Kenya will advise you well on this.

How much does new paragliding kit cost and how long can I use it for?

It depends on what you choose, estimated \$ 4500 – 5500.

If kept well you will enjoy flying with your gear 10-15 years. Paragliding Kit has great resell value.



Does my first paragliding kit have to be new or can I buy second hand gear?

There is a huge second-hand paraglider market online. The challenge is, that you will most probably order used gear from abroad. This can be tricky as you cannot visually inspect the gear before ordering it.

Therefore, we advise to purchase new paragliding kit from us. The advantage is, that you will be well advised of what to purchase and there are product warranties in place.

QUESTIONS ABOUT TRAINING

When do I become an independent pilot?

After PAK2 training.

If you feel confident to fly without supervision, talk to your instructor and he will advise you.

After PAK guidelines, you can fly without radio supervision after PAK3 level, but you can request to fly independently after PAK2 training

Do you issue a Kenya Paragliding License?

The Paragliding Association of Kenya (PAK) can issue you a license, endorsing your paragliding skill levels PAK1 to PAK5 in it in the [PAK Paragliding License Booklet](#).

QUESTIONS ABOUT EQUIPMENT ORDER

What is the shipment time of ordered paragliding kit?

Ordered equipment is shipped from Europe and it usually takes 3-4 weeks for equipment to be in your hands in Kenya

What about European VAT exemption as Cloudbase Kenya ships gear from Europe?

You can either have the equipment ordered to a European address and take it with you as your check-in luggage. With Export papers the VAT can be exempted. However, if you order it directly to Kenya the shipment will be paid inclusive EU VAT but due to the shipper no Kenyan Import Tax will be charged and it comes in as USD15 per kg.

Can I pay a deposit and full amount later?

After you confirm your order, we will send you a Proforma Invoice with Banking details.

Only full upfront payment makes the order possible.
